# **Treasurer's Report**

- Renewed the post office box

## Business

- 1. Treasurer position
  - a. Carrie is resigning effective Dec 31 2023
  - b. Erin Roach has agreed to take this position, we will put this to vote at the next meeting
- 2. Female ice sessions Tristin
  - a. Applied for a sanction in order to apply for a BC Hockey grant for female ice sessions
    - i. Obtaining a quote from Mark MacNaughton to conduct about 6-8 sessions for females

- ii. In the past, minor hockey has sponsored an ice block and then the town sponsored one
- b. Proposal that Minor Hockey would pay for three sessions if the grant is not approved, or delayed (about \$300 and free ice) *Moved by: Tyler Willis, Seconded: Mandy, all in favour, approved.*
- 3. Second ref clinic for those who need to recertify by Dec
  - a. Need posse players to get their online course and crim check
  - b. Dec 13th workshop in Kelowna is available for recert
  - c. Aim to get another recert course available in town
- 4. Concessions hours
  - a. Contract food vendor didn't show up to some of the games at the beginning of the season, and then opened the following weekend Sophie has provided the game schedule to them
- 5. Player movement and player evaluation
  - a. We feel that the current bylaws address a player moving up a level permanently, but do not address a player practicing up
  - b. Discussion and conclusion of the board:
    - If a player will practice up a level, this is up to the discretion of the upper-level head coach of that team. If they need support with these decisions or there are concerns, they can be addressed with the PMHA Head Coach
    - If a player will be on the roster as an AP, an evaluation by the PMHA Head Coach is required. Team numbers are considered by the coach, an AP would not play a game with a full rostered team. (Max at a game is 17 players on a bench and a goalie)
